# **Gateway River Ramble**

## **0.25 mile loop (Easy)**

The Gateway River Ramble is a short loop walking trail at the Town of Walpole's Gateway property. It features outstanding views of the Connecticut River.

### **To reach the trailhead**

The Walpole Gateway is located on the west side of Route 12, just southwest of its junction with South Street and just south of the veterinary hospital. Go to the kiosk at the south end of the upper field. From there, walk down the farm road to the boat drop-off area. Slightly right and towards the river is a sign marking the start of the Ramble.

### **The trail**

From the sign, follow the trail to the bluff at the river's edge. Turn right (north) and enjoy scenic views of the Connecticut River as you walk along the bank. There is a viewing bench for your pleasure. The trail then turns inland and circles around a corn field back to the boat drop-off area. Take care not to damage any agricultural crops.

### **Parking**

There are several mowed parking spots to the left of the veterinary hospital access road, just past Walker Road. It is also possible to park in the field to the left of the entrance to the farm road, near the kiosk.

### **Risk**

All trails come with inherent risks. Please take precautionary measures to protect yourself from ticks, poison ivy, and other potential hazards.
